Entries

The riders must hold a license issued in 2014 for the riders of the BikeTrial International Union. (According to art.03 of the International Technical Regulations BIU) the record boundary riders of any nation is 20 per day (according to Article 26. Registration). The riders of a country where there is no delegate, BIU should send the application form through the representative of the BIU for the geographic area (ex EBU Europe for riders, for riders of BAU Asia). Pilots from other areas must contact directly BIU.

Course fee,

The amount is 30€ per riders which must be paid by the delegate (or team leader) Spanish delegate, before the first meeting of the Jury of the event, on Friday August 8th, 2014. (Pursuant to Section 26).

Awards

Cash prizes for top 3 of ELIT class are:

1,000€ for the 1st. 600€ for the 2nd and 400€ for the 3rd.

They will also have medals or trophies the top 3 finishers in each category.

Insurance,

Each pilot must have accident insurance covered by their own license.

The organizing medical services that will set the BIU rules. If there is any hospitalization, it will give the ambulance service to the hospital.

All hospital services that are outside the scope of compulsory insurance for the rider, the rider will be charged.

There will always be at least one ambulance in the race.

All runners and participants must have accident insurance.
